Bulmershe Summer School 2021, Monday 26th July – Friday 30th July

Summer school will run between 09:30 and 14:30. Students should arrive at the main school reception where they can be registered and welcomed into summer school. Collection will take place at 14:30. As stated in the confirmation and travel form, **anyone collecting students MUST be named on the form and must bring ID with them to be checked**. Students who have been listed as walking home on the collection letter will be released at 14:30. A general outline of the day is included below:

12:00 – 12:30	Lunch
12:30 – 13:30	Lesson 3
13:30 – 14:30	Lesson 4
14:30	Dismissal and collection

Throughout the day students will take part in a variety of fun and engaging activities, which will help them learn more about the Bulmershe School and its values, as well as build relationships with staff and students. In order to help them make the most of the day students will need to bring:

- Comfortable footwear and clothing suitable for running around, including outside.
- Water bottle
- Medication (if already stated on medical form, to be labelled clearly with your child's name and handed in at registration)
- Sun hat.*
- Sun cream (to be applied prior to arriving at summer school).*
- Raincoat/waterproof.*

*Weather dependent

Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name. Students may bring a mobile phone to school, so long as they are switched off and in their bags before they enter the school site at the start of the day and remain there unless they are needed for an emergency and they have the express permission of a member of staff. Should your child be caught using their mobile phone between 09:30 and 14:30 without permission, it will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day.



Lunch will be provided for students so please ensure any allergies and dietary requirements are clearly listed on the linked medical form.

COVID 19

If you or your child show symptoms of COVID 19, please self-isolate and book a PCR test through calling the NHS 119 or via the NHS testing and tracing for coronavirus website. Common symptoms of COVID 19 may include:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss in sense of taste or smell

Should your child have to isolate, please inform the school of their absence by emailing jbungay@bulmershe.wokingham.sch.uk. Should you or your child test positive for COVID 19, please ensure you notify the school immediately using the same contact details and follow government advice to self-isolate.
